Rains pouring on Cox's Bazar district, massive numbers of displaced population under dire circumstances and discussion of potential relocation of some of the displaced, the needs in the Southern part of Bangladesh for the affected communities are far from decreasing. With no immediate prospect for return, the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society, ICRC, IFRC, and supporting partner Red Cross Red Crescent National Societies have no other choice but to step up their assistance efforts to improve the living conditions of the affected communities, be they displaced from Myanmar or resident communities seeing their environment and livelihoods hugely impacted by the situation.
