SUDAN

In the early morning of Saturday, 15 April 2023, Khartoum woke up to the sound of gunfire and explosions. This was the first time that the capital city of Sudan, home to 6 million people, was at the epicentre of a fierce conflict between two powerful groups, the Sudan Armed Forces (SAF) and the Rapid Support Forces (RSF).

The Sudanese Red Crescent Society (SRCS), International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent (IFRC) have been at the forefront of the response since the early hours providing critical and lifesaving support to those affected. Thousands of volunteers have been working around the clock, close to the frontlines assisting people in critical situations through their vast network across the country.

All components of the Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement - National Societies, IFRC, ICRC - have coordinated their efforts to support the Sudanese Red Crescent to respond to the humanitarian needs. This support will continue in the days, weeks, and months ahead.

THE MOVEMENT

The International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement is a global humanitarian network of 80 million people that helps those facing disaster, conflict, and health and social problems. It consists of the 191 National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies, the International Federation of Red Cross (IFRC) and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC)

Considering the financial resources obtained so far, ensuring SRCS business continuity across the 18 states and all district branches has been a priority to ensure that frontline humanitarian services are provided through principles of humanitarian action, including IDP needs assessments, the protocol related to the recovery of human remains and establishment of humanitarian service points.

REGIONAL IMPACT

People arriving in neighbouring countries have endured a very dire humanitarian situation in Sudan, with many having been caught in the crossfire or at border crossings for several weeks without sustained access to basic goods and services such as water, food and healthcare, all while under tremendous psychological pressure. Many have endured harassment and extortion.

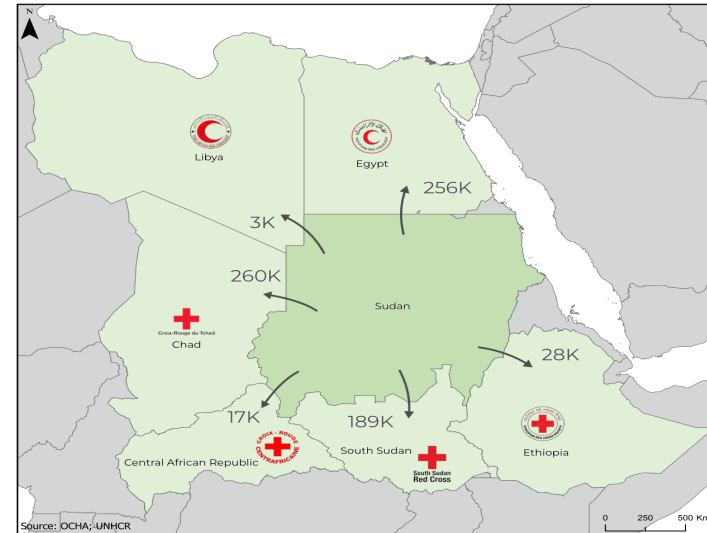
